#### IMPORTANT MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- 1) Carefully read and keep pages 1 & 2 of registration.
- 2) **Fill out** all steps on page 3 & 4 of registration and **return** to the Guelph Curling Club.
- 3) Returning member registrations are due **NO LATER** than September 13th, 2008. We ask registrations be on time so that your name will appear in this years Club Directory and league coordinators have time to do league draws. Members must ensure their payment has been received by the club **BEFORE** the member starts to curl in any league.
- 4) Membership payments can now be made by equal payments (date of registration return to April 2009) with Visa or MasterCard.
- 5) Please note to anyone registering for an OCA event, this year teams will not be able to represent the Guelph Curling Club unless the team has paid the OCA fee *before* the club registration due date.

#### DEFINITION OF FEES

**LATE REGISTRATION FEE**—Any returning members registering after November 14th, 2008 will be charged a \$20 late fee.

**HALF SEASON**—Membership fees are available for 50% of listed fees.

**PRO-RATE**—Memberships may be pro-rated, contact office for details.

**SHARE BILLING**—All new members, age 25 or older, must purchase a share (\$50.00) after 2 years curled at the Guelph Curling Club. Members leaving the club may have their share returned (\$45.00) or transferred.

**CAPITAL FUND**—This fee is paid every year (\$25.00). Little Rock/Bantam/Junior/Under 21/High School and University Students are exempt.

**TAXES**—Taxes are included in membership fees.

**ADMINISTRATION FEE**—A member will be charged \$20.00 for any N.S.F. cheque.

**OCA MEMBERSHIP FEE**—An Ontario Curling Association fee of \$12/adult member and \$7/junior member is included in the membership fees.

**LOCKER & LOCK**—Lockers can be obtained at the office for a fee of \$25 (includes taxes). Locks are provided by the club. Lockers must be emptied the last day of the season.

**SPARING**—Non Members/New Members are able to play up to 5 games for no cost and then must pay \$15/game. Spares are asked to check in with the office before playing any games. If the office is closed please check in at the bar or with the league coordinator. This also includes limited members that are playing in only one league and wish to spare in another.

**PRACTICE ICE**—Members may practice at no cost however must book practice ice with the office. Non Members can pay a Practice Fee for the year (see page 4) or must pay \$15/person for a maximum of 2 hrs. This fee can be paid at the office or at the bar.

## LEAGUE INFORMATION AND DESCRIPTIONS

LEAGUE TYPE	DESCRIPTION
<b>Social</b>	These leagues are open to all members. Teams are made up by the committees and they stay the same for a 5 week round. At the end of the 5 weeks new teams are made up. These leagues are available to all levels of curlers. A curler new to the game can easily integrate into any one of these leagues. This is a good starting spot as the leagues are very social and the player gets to curl with many people over the course of the season.
<b>Mixed</b>	<b>Friday Morning Mixed League</b> is open to adult members regardless of gender. The league runs as a jitney where teams are made up each day of the event. Curlers new to the game can easily integrate into this league. <b>Friday Night Social League</b> is open to adult members regardless of gender. A curler new to the game can easily integrate into this league. Teams are made up by the committee and like other social leagues they stay the same for a 5 week round.
<b>Open</b>	These leagues are available to members regardless of gender. Teams may be made up of any combination of male and female players. These leagues implement a tiered structure that allows any level of curler (from novice to experienced) to enjoy and compete. A curler new to the game can easily integrate into any one of these leagues. Individual, partial or team entries are accepted.
<b>Competitive, Choose Your Own Team (CYOT) &amp; Team Play</b>	These leagues are team entry only. Teams are entered into divisions. At the completion of each round, teams move up or down based on their performance. Please contact the curling club if you are interested but do not have a team.
<b>Men's Jam</b>	This league is open to men of any age. The league runs as a jitney where teams are made up each day of the event. There is a charge of \$2.00 per person for each game above the membership and each draw the winning team receives a bottle of jam or pickles. This is a very active and fun league.
<b>Little Rock, Bantam and Junior</b>	These leagues are made up of Little Rocks (6-9yrs), Bantam (10-16 yrs.) and Junior (16-20yrs). It is open to all youth regardless of skill level. The league incorporates a teaching element based on a badge system as well as game experience with volunteer coaches. These are very good starter leagues and allows youth to learn at their own pace. The programs run on Sundays between 1 & 4 pm. Instruction and game time is determined by number of registrations in program.
